<u>TuneCable Spotify Converter Mac</u> version is designed for converting Spotify songs, albums, podcasts, audiobooks, or playlists to local storage, offering the highest output audio quality and various formats to meet your needs on Mac. TuneCable Spotify Music Converter is one of the best Spotify music converters on Mac that combines downloading and converting functions altogether.

Moreover, TuneCable Spotify Music Converter Mac version enables users to convert Spotify tracks to MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF and ALAC formats with almost all ID3 tags kept after conversion. It also provides other useful functions like playback, tag editing and format converter.




Register TuneCable Spotify Converter for Mac

Step 1. Go to the lower left corner and click the "Register" tab. You can also click the top-right menu button and choose "Register" in the drop-down list, you will get the registration interface.

Step 2. Copy and paste the Email and Code you receive in the email into the registration dialog. Then hit on the **"Register"** button to confirm.



Note: The registration info is case-sensitive. Please do not add a blank at the beginning or the end of the word. Make sure both the Email address and key code are the same as what we provided in the confirmation email after purchasing the program. If not, an error message will show:


Installation

To install this program, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Download TuneCable Spotify Converter Mac version from **Download Page**.
- 2. Double click the installation file **tunecable-sp-downloader.dmg** to install the program.
- 3. Follow the instruction to finish the installation.

Main Interface


After you launch TuneCable Spotify Converter for Mac, you will see the primary interface below:



Menu


When clicking the menu

The "Tools" section has 2 value-added features, which are "Format Converter" and "Tag Edit".







TuneCable Spotify Converter for Mac version supports two working modes, it can download the songs from both the Spotify app and the Spotify web player. The operations are a bit different, and this user guide will show them respectively. Additionally, TuneCable provides several helpful tool to give you a better user experience. We will show the operations as well.

Download Spotify Music to Mac with Spotify App

Step 1. Select to use the Spotify app to download songs from the primary interface, and TuneCable will apply the app mode interface, followed by the pre-install Spotify app launch. You need to log in to your Spotify account on the app to access its music library.






Step 2. Next, go to the "**Settings**" interface to choose an output format, sound quality, and other output settings. There are many parameters you can choose from.


- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Spotify Record, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album

Note: If you prefer the source format and the original sound quality, select 'AUTO' from Output Format and 'Spotify Record' from Conversion Mode.







Step 3. Direct to the Spotify app and go to find the target Spotify songs, playlists, artists, podcasts, or albums you would like to convert. Please drag and drop the track from Spotify to the specific area of TuneCable directly. Or you can copy the link (Click "..." of the track or right-click to choose "Share" >> "Copy Song Link"/"Copy Spotify URL"), then go back to TuneCable and paste the link into the input box. TuneCable will loads the songs on a popup, you can pick them and click on "Add".




Step 4. If you would like to add more songs to this batch, you can click "Add" on this interface, or simply repeat the drag and drop. When finish adding, click the "Convert" button to start conversion. And TuneCable will proceed with the songs while preserving the full ID3 tags.







Step 5. After the conversion is complete, you can find the converted audio files by clicking the "Converted" module, and enjoy Spotify music on your way.



Download Spotify Music with Spotify Web Player

Step 1. Choose to use the Spotify web player on the primary interface. TuneCable will enter the web player download mode, and the Spotify web player will appear as an independent window. Follow the tips to log in to your account.






Step 2. Go back to the TuneCable interface after logging, and navigate to the "**Settings**" module, where you can personalize the output settings. These settings include but are not limited to the following options.


- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Web Download, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album


If you want the output files with the same format and audio quality as the source Spotify music, choose 'AUTO' from Output Format and 'Web Download' from Conversion Mode.






Step 3. Move to the Spotify web player, and go through your songs, playlists, albums, podcasts, and audiobooks. Click the "Click to add" button and TuneCable will load and display the songs on a popup. Pick the songs and choose "Add". When you want to add more Spotify songs to this batch, simply repeat this step.






Step 4. Simply click the "Convert" button to start the download immediately. And TuneCable will run at up to 10x fast speed.





Step 5. After conversion, click "Converted" to find your converted Spotify Music tracks. Thereafter, you can enjoy Spotify music freely, without limitations.




Format Converter

This function allows you to convert music file to 6 different formats with converted music or music in local files. You can convert them to MP3, M4A, FLAC, WAV, AIFF and OGG.

Step 1. Go to Format Converter from the Tools module. Click "+Add" to open and browse your local files. Then select the files and confirm to upload them to TuneCable. Another easy way to upload the files is by dragging and dropping. The source files should be in MP3, M4A, M4B, WAV, FLAC, OGG, AIFF, or M4R format.

Step 2. Move your cursor to the right bar on TuneCable, and select an output format, sound quality, channel, and output path. Next, click **"Convert"** to start the conversion.




Tag Edit

Tag Edit, or tag editor, is the function that allows you to edit all the important and useful meta information to your local audio files or the converted Spotify songs to your preference.

Step 1. Head to Tag Edit from the Tools module, and import your local files by clicking the "+Add" button or dragging and dropping. If you would like to modify the converted Spotify songs on TuneCable, go to the "Converted" module, choose the songs, and select "Edit Tag" after clicking the four-square icon.

Step 2. TuneCable will smartly identify and display the ID3 tags, and you can make changes to Artwork, Title, Artist, Album, Genre, Year, and Track Num. Then hit on "Save" to apply all the changes.




Export to iTunes

If you would like to transfer the converted Spotify songs to your iTunes library, you can do that with a few clicks on TuneCable.

Step 1. After the conversion, head to the "Converted" module, and pick the target songs. Then click the four-square icon above the items and select "Export to iTunes" from the drop-down list.

Step 2. After that, a popup will appear. You can name this playlist accordingly, then click on **"Start exporting"** to begin the transfer.
