<u>TuneCable Spotify Converter Windows</u> version is designed for converting Spotify songs or playlists to local storage, and offers the highest output audio quality and various formats to meet your needs on Windows. TuneCable Spotify Converter is one of the best Spotify Music converters on Windows which can convert any Spotify song with 10X faster speed than other audio recorders do.

TuneCable Spotify Music Converter Windows version supports converting Spotify audio to MP3, AAC, WAV, FLAC, AIFF, and ALAC formats with ID3 tags kept after conversion. Other useful functions like playback, export Spotify playlist to iTunes directly, CD burner are all available in the Tool section.




Register TuneCable Spotify Converter for Win

Step 1. You can directly click the "Register" tab in the lower left corner or click the top-right "Menu" button and choose "Register" in the drop-down list, and you will get the registration interface.

Step 2. Copy and paste the registration Email and Code into the registration box, and then click the "Register" button.



Note: The registration info is case-sensitive. And, please do not add a blank at the beginning or the end of the word. Make sure both the email address and key code are the same as what we provided in the confirmation email after purchasing the program. If not, an error message will show:


Installation

To install this product, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Download TuneCable Spotify Converter Windows version from **Download Page**.
- 2. Double click the installation file tunecable-spotify-downloader.exe to install the program.
- 3. Follow the instruction to finish the installation.
- 4. Then you will see there is an icon of the program on the desktop.

Main Interface


After you launch TuneCable Spotify Converter for Win, you will see the primary interface below:



Menu


When clicking the menu

button, you will see the menu list like this:




Language Bar





TuneCable Spotify Converter supports two working modes, it can work with the Spotify app and the Spotify web player to download songs. The operations are a bit different, and we will show them respectively in this user guide. Additionally, we will show you the operation to use the handy tools.

Download Spotify Music with the App

Step 1. Launch Spotify Converter on Windows. You will see the primary interface where you can select a working mode. Here select the Spotify App to work with TuneCable. Then TuneCable will enter the app mode, and the Spotify app opens automatically. Please sign in to your Spotify account. A Free account is allowed.






Step 2. Click the "Settings" tab in the left bar, and then there will be an interface that allows you to set the output parameters.


- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Spotify Record, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album

To save the original quality and source format, select 'AUTO' from Output Format. Besides, it is recommended to select 'Spotify Record' as the conversion mode.







Step 3. Please drag and drop the track from the Spotify app to the specific detect area in TuneCable directly. Or you can copy the link (Click "..." of the track or right click to choose "Share" >> "Copy Song Link"/"Copy Spotify URL"), then go back to TuneCable and paste the link into the input box. TuneCable will smartly parse and load the songs on a popup. Pick your target songs and click "Add".







Step 4. All tracks that you need to convert will be listed below. If you still want to add more Spotify songs to this batch, click the "Add" button or directly drag and drop another playlist to TuneCable. After adding all the songs, simply click on "Convert" to start the conversion.











Note: If you need to share or transfer the converted Spotify music, you could click the icon with four squares above the converted songs. TuneCable provides 3 options for you, which are "Burn CD", "Edit Tag" and "Export to iTunes". TuneCable also offers a music playback function.

Download Spotify Music with the Web Player

Step 1. Open the TuneCable program on your computer, and select the web player mode from the primary page. TuneCable will enter the web player mode, and the Spotify web player will pop up as an independent window. Please log in to your Spotify account.







Step 2. Go to the "**Settings**" tab in the left bar, and then there will be an interface that allows you to set the output parameters.


- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Web Download, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album

To save the original quality and source format, select 'AUTO' from Output Format. Besides, it is recommended to select 'Web Download' as the conversion mode.




Step 3. Go through the songs, playlists, albums, and podcasts on Spotify, and click on the blue **"Click to add"** button. TuneCable will load the songs on a popup. Pick your target songs and hit on **"Add"**. If you want to add more songs, simply do this step again.









Step 4. After adding the songs, click on the "Convert" button to download the Spotify songs to your local computer. TuneCable proceeds with them at up to 10x the speed, and saves ID3 tags of the tracks.





Step 5. When the conversion is complete, you can check the downloaded songs in the "Converted" tab or go to the output folder. Then you can enjoy Spotify songs freely.




Export to iTunes

TuneCable supports exporting the downloaded Spotify songs to iTunes Library directly.

Step 1. After the conversion, go to the "Converted" module and select the items you want to transfer. Click on the icon with four little squares and select "Export to iTunes" from the list.

Step 2. A pop up will then appear, where you are allowed to name the playlist. Then hit on the **"Start exporting"** button to launch the transfer.




Format Converter

This function allows you to convert music files to 6 different formats with converted music or your local audio files. They are MP3, M4A, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, and OGG.

Step 1. From the "Tools" page, choose the Format Converter option. You can add local music to the interface by clicking the "**+Add**" button or by manually dragging and dropping them. The supported source format includes MP3, M4A, M4B, WAV, FLAC, OGG, AIFF, and M4R.

Step 2. Select the output format, sound quality (128kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps), channel (Mono, Stereo), and output path. Then click **"Convert"** to start the conversion.




Burn CD

This function allows you to burn converted and existing music files to a CD for a maximum of 80 minutes.

Step 1. Once you have clicked into the Burn CD tool, you can drag and drop your favorite local songs into the margins or select the "+Add" button to add them. If you want to burn the converted songs on TuneCable, please head to the "Converted" tab, select the target songs, and select "Burn CD" after clicking the four-square icon.

Step 2. Then you can customize the name of the disc as well as the gap between songs. You should note that you can add a maximum of 80 minutes of songs in total. Click on **"Burn"** to start the progress.




Tag Edit

This function allows you to edit the ID3 tags of a song. You can change the information of Artwork, Title, Artist, Album, Genre, Year, and Track Num.

Step 1. Access the Edit Tag module from the Tools page. For the target file selection, click the "+Add" button to browse your local folder and add your target files. Dragging and dropping are also allowed. If you would like to edit the tags of the converted songs on TuneCable, then go to the "Converted" tab, select the converted songs, and select "Edit Tag" after clicking the four-square icon.

Step 2. TuneCable will smartly read and display the tags of the tracks. Then you can add tags to the selected audio or modify the tags to your preference. Finally, click on "Save" to apply all the changes.
