<u>TuneCable iTadal Music Converter for Mac</u> is a specialist in removing the encoded restraints on Tidal Music tracks, which liberates Tidal users from only being authorized to play songs with the Tidal Music app or web player. With this skillful tool, you can own perpetual admission to your Tidal collections anytime and anywhere.

Moreover, TuneCable iTadal Music Converter for Mac version enables users to convert Tidal tracks to MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF and ALAC formats with almost all ID3 tags kept after conversion. It also provides other useful functions like playback, tag editing and format converter.

Key Features

- Download Tidal songs, albums, playlists, and podcasts onto local Mac.
- Convert Tidal tracks to MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, and ALAC formats.
- Save HiFi/MQA Tidal music without quality loss.
- Keep full ID3 tags after the conversion.
- Proceed with Tidal songs at up to 10X fast speed in batch.
- Tidal Free, HiFi, and HiFi Plus plans are feasible to download songs.
- Support both the TIDAL app and the Tidal Web Player.
- More tools: Format Converter, Edit Tag.

- The latest Tidal is recommended.




Register TuneCable iTadal Music Converter for Mac

Step 1. Navigate to the top right of TuneCable, then tap on the "Menu" icon. In the drop-down list, choose "Register". Or you can directly click on the "Register" tab in the lower left. Afterward, the registration interface will open.

Step 2. Simply copy and paste the registration Email and Code that you receive in the email into the registration dialog. Then click the "Register" button.



Note: The registration info is case sensitive. Please do not add a blank at the beginning or the end of the word. Make sure both the Email address and key code are the same as what we provided in the confirmation email after purchasing the program. If not, an error message will pop up as below:


Installation

To install this program, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Download TuneCable iTadal Music Converter Mac version from **Download Page**.
- 2. Double click the installation file **tunecable-itadal-music-converter.dmg** to install the program.
- 3. Follow the instruction to finish the installation.

Main Interface


After you launch TuneCable iTadal Music Converter for Mac, you will see the main interface below:









Since TuneCable has two download modes, and they are a bit different, we will show them respectively. Let's take a look at how to download songs, albums, podcasts, and playlists from Tidal to a local Mac.

Download Tidal Music onto Mac with TIDAL App

Step 1. Log in to Your Tidal Music Account on Mac

After starting TuneCable iTadal Music Converter and selecting the app download mode, the Tidal Music app will be initiated automatically. Please log in to your Tidal account to access its library. Then move to the next step.






Step 2. Set Up the Output Parameters

Go to the "Settings" interface that allows you to set the output parameters. TuneCable provides 6 download formats, you can convert songs to MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF and ALAC formats. Other settings parameters like conversion mode, output quality, saving path, naming format are ready for you to customize. Then you just need to close the window directly to apply the settings.

- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Tidal Record, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album


Note: 'AUTO' is the option that you can use to output Tidal tracks with the source format and audio quality. If you hesitate in the conversion mode, then 'Tidal Record' is the best option.





Step 3. Add Tracks or Playlists from Tidal to TuneCable


Move to the TIDAL app, drag and drop the track from Tidal to the specific detect area in TuneCable directly. Or you can copy the link (right-click the song, and then choose "Share" >> "Copy Track Link" or right-click the title of an album/playlist, then choose "Copy link address"), then go back to TuneCable and paste the link into the input box. Then TuneCable will analyze the songs and show them on a popup. Pick your preferred songs and hit on "Add".






Step 4. Start Converting Tidal Music Tracks

If you are going to add more songs, just repeat the previous step. Then simply click on "Convert" to start converting the Tidal Music tracks. During the conversion, TuneCable can save up to MQA music.








Step 5. Check Converted Tidal Music Tracks

Once the process is completed, you can go to the **"Converted"** section and enjoy the free playback of the Tidal songs freely.







Download Tidal Music with Tidal Web Player

Step 1. Log in to Access Tidal Music

After selecting the Tidal web player download mode, TuneCable will apply a different user interface from the app mode. And the Tidal web player occurs as an independent window. You are required to log in to your account.








Step 2. Modify Output Settings as Needed

It is important to change the output settings before downloading if you would like customized output files. Simply go to the "Settings" tab, where you are given the following options.

- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Web Download, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album


Note: 'AUTO' is the option that you can use to output Tidal tracks with the source format and audio quality. If you prefer the HiFi quality, then choosing 'AUTO' or 'FLAC' from Output Format is necessary.






Step 3. Add Target Tidal Music Songs

Now look at the Tidal web player, browse and open any songs, playlists, albums, or podcasts you want, until you see a blue "Click to add" button. Click on the button and TuneCable will display the songs on a popup, where you can pick the items freely. Then click "Add" to add the songs to the download list of TuneCable. To add more songs, simply repeat this step.









Step 4. Convert Tidal Music at Fast Speed

After all the songs are added to TuneCable, you need to click "Convert" to start converting Tidal songs onto your Mac. TuneCable can download songs at up to 10x fast speed, and you don't have to wait for too long.








Step 5. Browse Downloaded Tidal Music

Once the conversion is done, you can check the downloaded songs from the output folder or go to the **"Converted"** tab to do more.






Format Converter

This function allows you to convert music file to 6 different formats with converted music or music in local files. You can convert them to MP3, M4A, FLAC, WAV, AIFF and OGG.

Step 1. Click on Format Converter from Tools. Click "+Add" to import local audio files. Also, you are allowed to drag and drop audio to this format converter from Mac directly. And the source audio files should be in MP3, M4A, M4B, WAV, FLAC, OGG, AIFF, or M4R format.

Step 2. After importing, you can change the output format, sound quality, channel, and output folder as you wish. Finally, click on **"Convert"**.






Tag Edit

Tag Edit, or ID3 tag editor, namely, is the easy-to-use function that allows you to change the tags or add ID3 tags to your local audio files or the converted Tidal music songs.

Step 1. Click on Tag Edit from Tools. Click "+Add" to import local audio files. Also, you are allowed to drag and drop audio to TuneCable from Mac directly. If you would like to make changes to the converted Tidal songs, go to the "Converted" section, select the songs, and choose "Edit Tag" after clicking on the four-square function icon.

Step 2. TuneCable will smartly read and display the tags of the audio. You can change the **Artwork, Title, Artist, Album, Genre, Year, and Track Num** of each track. Click **"Save"** to take effect immediately.






Export to iTunes

Except for the previous two value-added tools, TuneCable gives you the simple operation to transfer the converted Tidal songs to your iTunes library.

Step 1. After the conversion is finished, navigate to the "Converted" section, pick the converted items, and select "Export to iTunes" after hitting on the four-square function icon.

Step 2. A popup will then appear. You can name this playlist as you wish. Then simply click on **"Start exporting"** to begin the transfer.
