[TuneCable iTadal Converter Windows version](#) is applied in downloading songs, albums, podcasts, and playlists from Tidal to a computer locally with a Tidal Free, Tidal HiFi, or Tidal HiFi Plus account. TuneCable decrypts every Tidal track to unlock the full user experience. It converts Tidal Music tracks to common MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC formats without losing any audio quality. With TuneCable, Tidal users avail themselves of access to all favorite music collections anytime and anywhere.

Key Features

- Download Tidal songs, playlists, albums, and podcasts to local Windows PC.
- Convert Tidal tracks to MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, and ALAC formats.
- Preserve original HiFi/MQA audio quality and full ID3 Tags.
- Proceed with Tidal songs at up to 10X fast speed.
- Extract songs with Tidal Free, HiFi, and HiFi Plus accounts.
- Support both TIDAL app and Tidal web player.
- More tools: Format Converter, Tag Edit, etc.

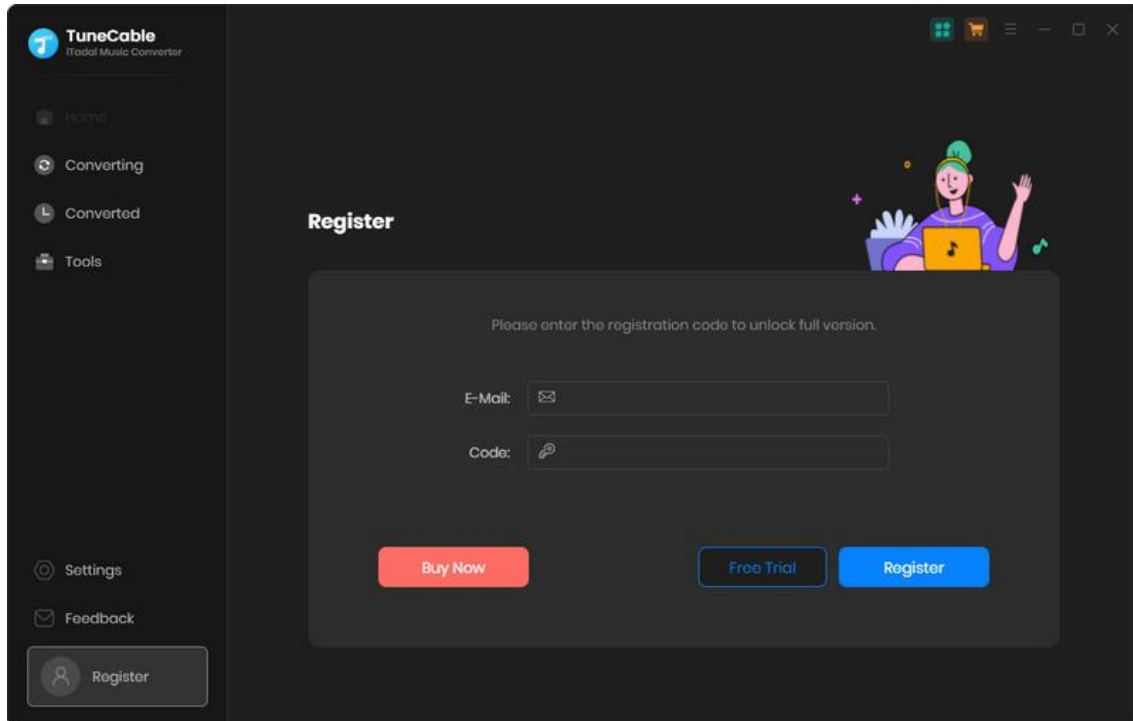
2. What benefits do I have after registration?

- You can enjoy FREE technical support.

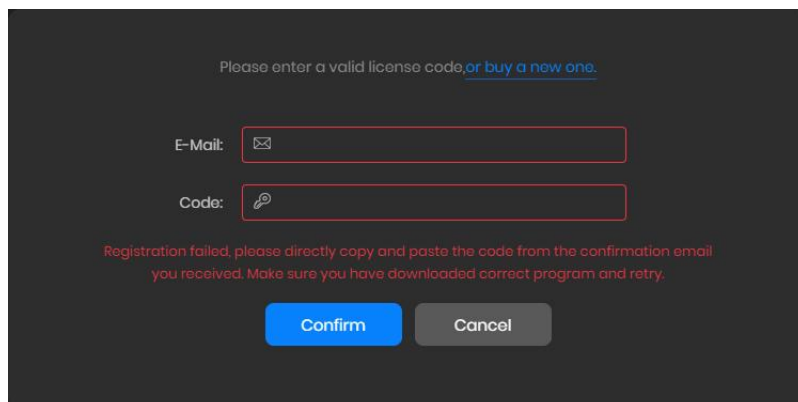
Register TuneCable iTadal Converter for Windows

Step 1. Start TuneCable Tidal Music Downloader and select a working mode. Then go to the lower left corner, and click the "**Register**" tab. You will see the registration interface.

Step 2. Copy and paste the registration Email and Code that you have received from the email into the registration box. Then click "**Register**".



Note: The registration info is case-sensitive. And, please do not add a blank at the beginning or the end of the word. Make sure both the Email address and key code are the same as what we provided in the confirmation email after purchasing the program. If not, an error message will pop up as below:

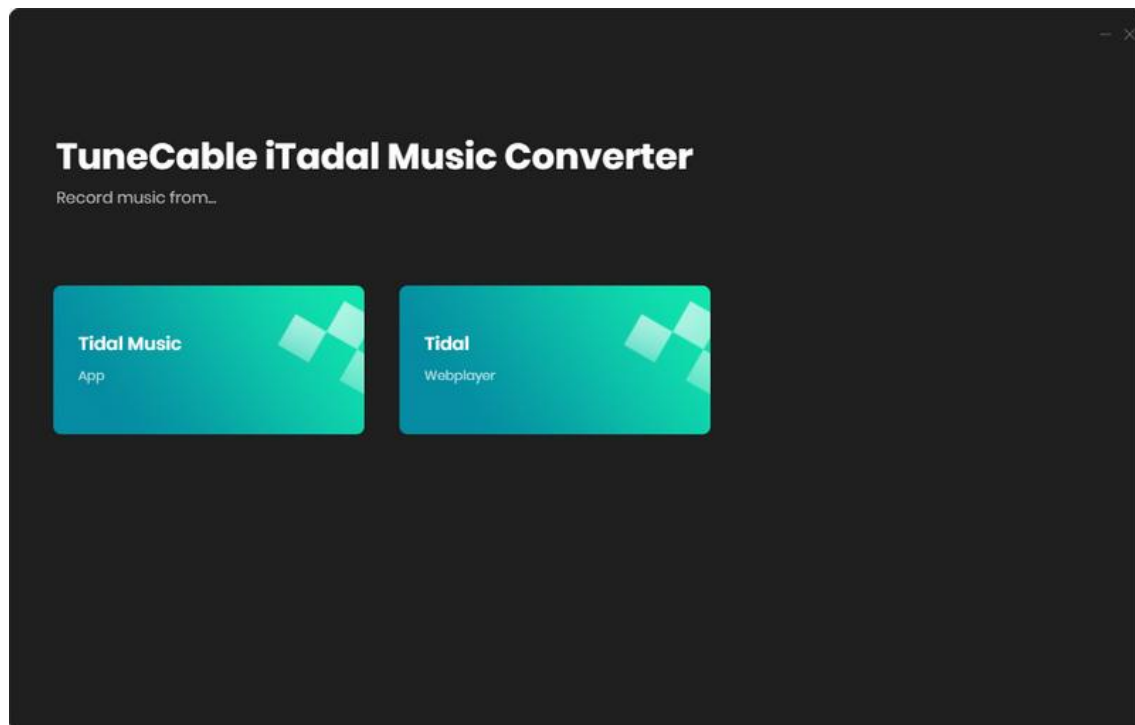
Installation

To install this product, please follow the steps below:


1. Download TuneCable iTadal Converter Windows version from [Download Page](#).
2. Double click the installation file [tunecable-itadal-music-converter.exe](#) to install the program.
3. Follow the instruction to finish the installation.

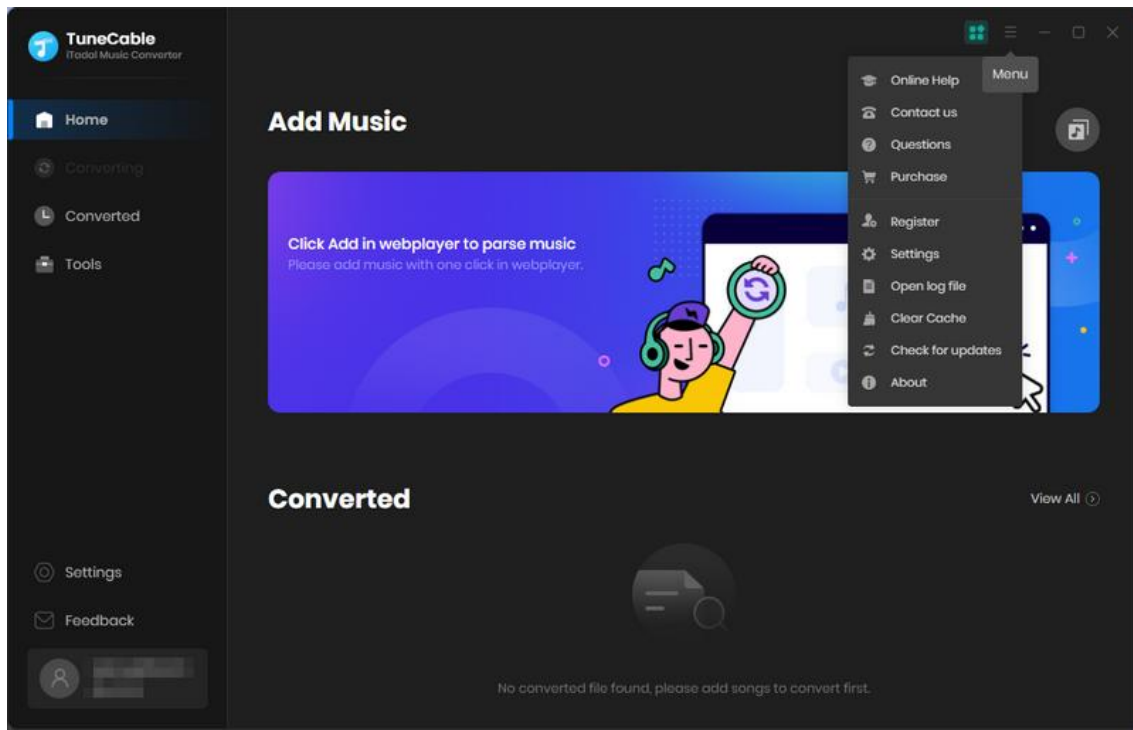
Main Interface

After you launch TuneCable iTadal Converter for Win, you will see the primary interface below:



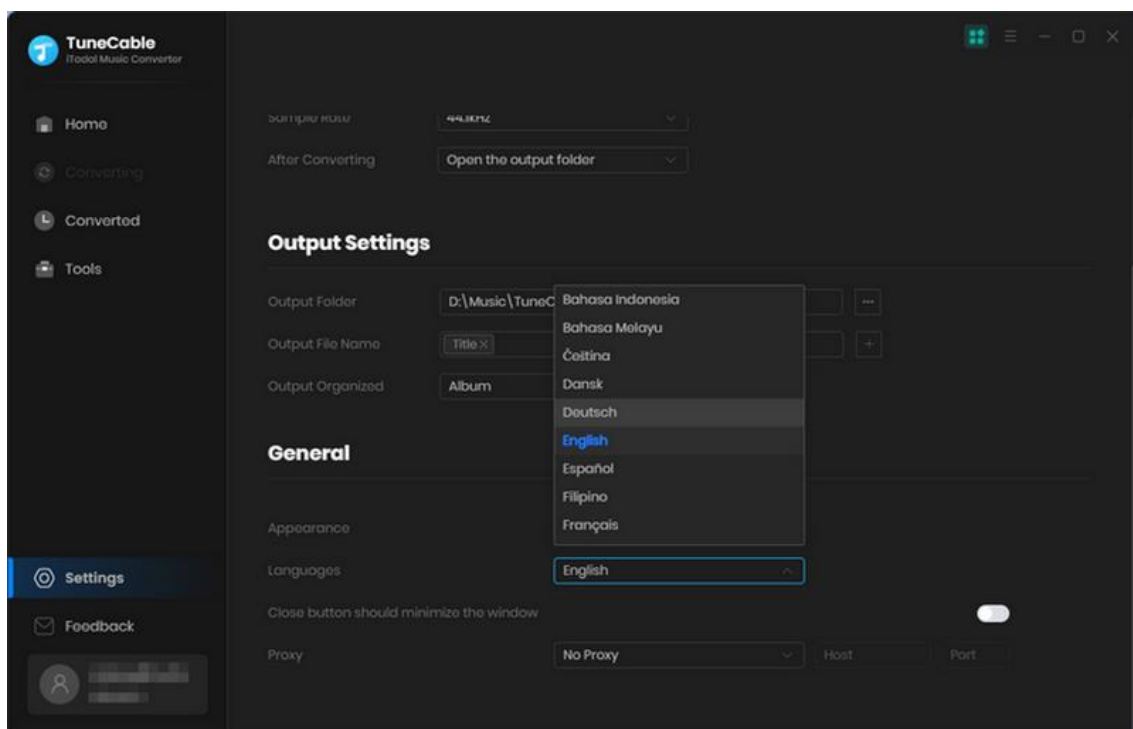
Menu

When clicking the menu  button, you will see the menu list like this:



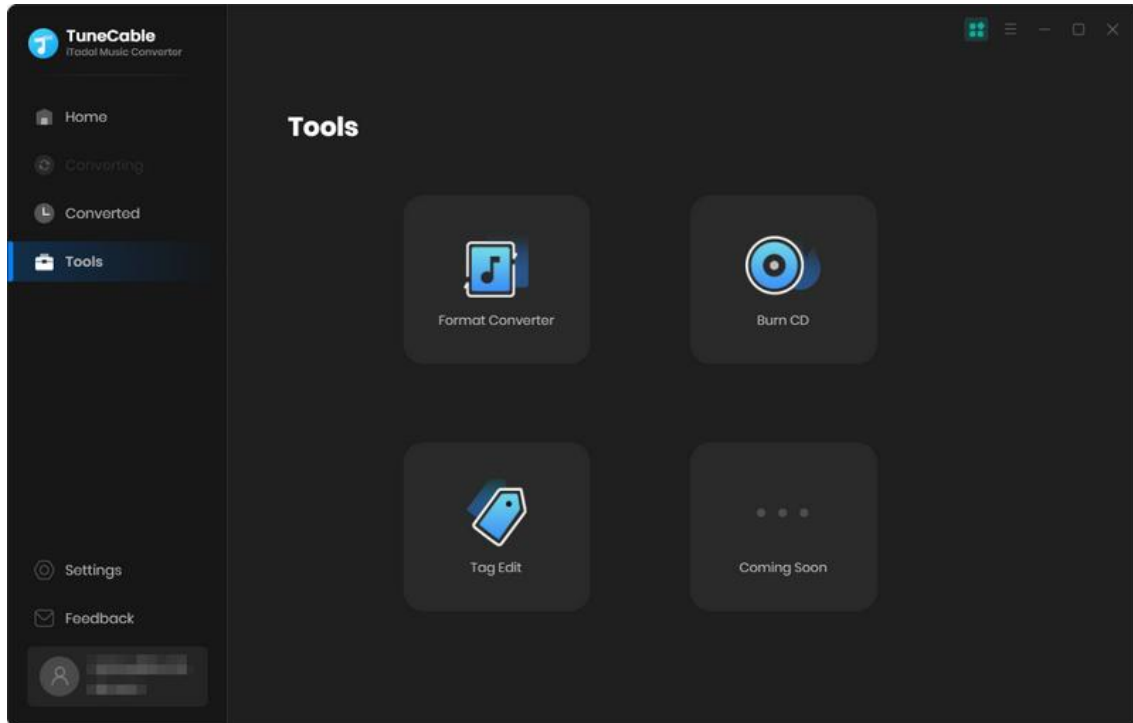
Language Bar

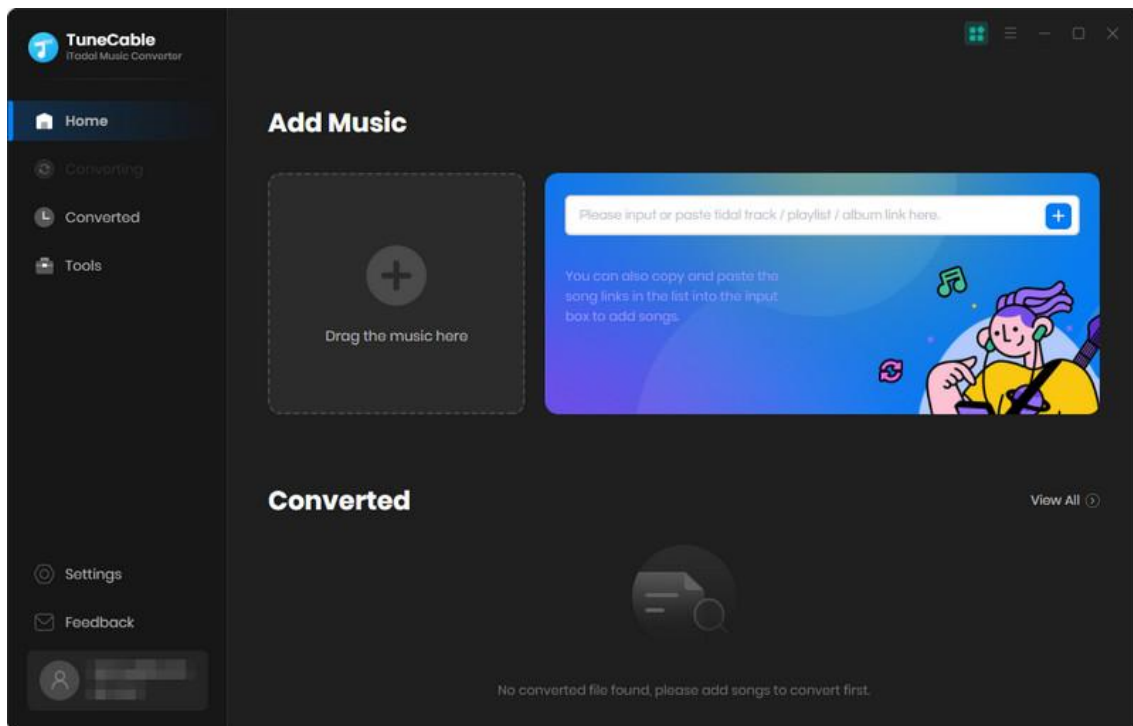

TuneCable iTadal Converter supports working through both the TIDAL app and Tidal Web Player, the operations are different, and we will show them respectively. Additionally, we will introduce to you how to use the handy tools on TuneCable.

Download Tidal Music with TIDAL App

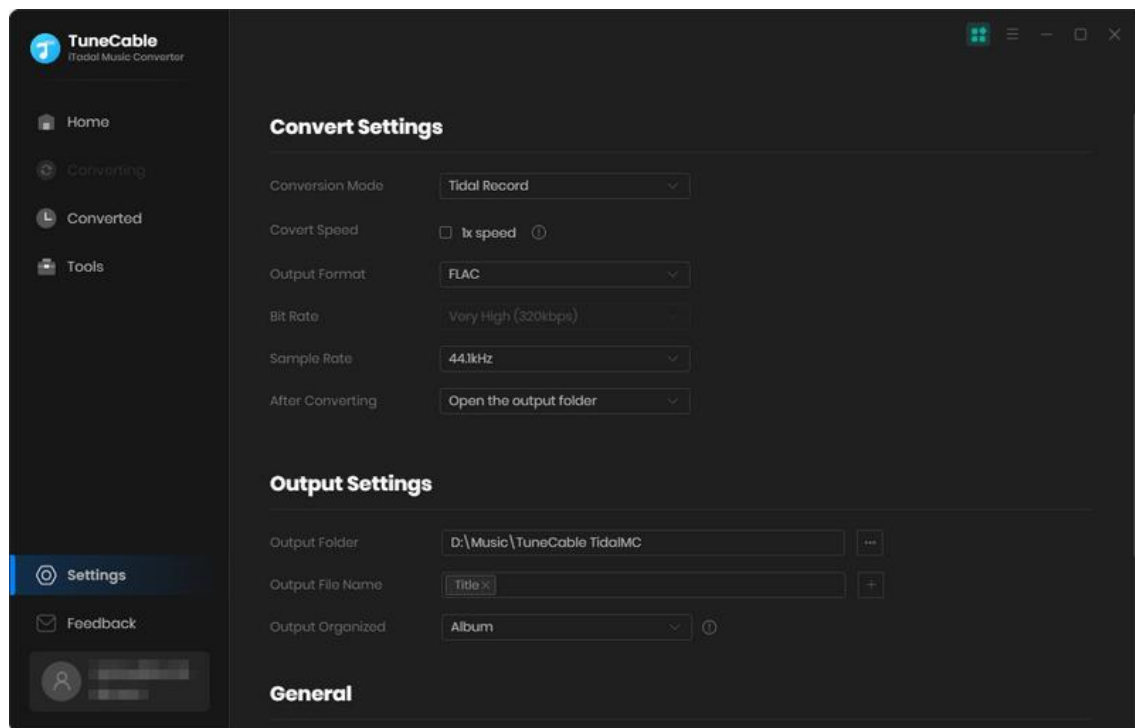
Step 1. After launching TuneCable on your PC and selecting to use the TIDAL app, TuneCable will enter the app mode and the pre-install TIDAL app will open automatically. You need to log in to your Tidal account to access its library.



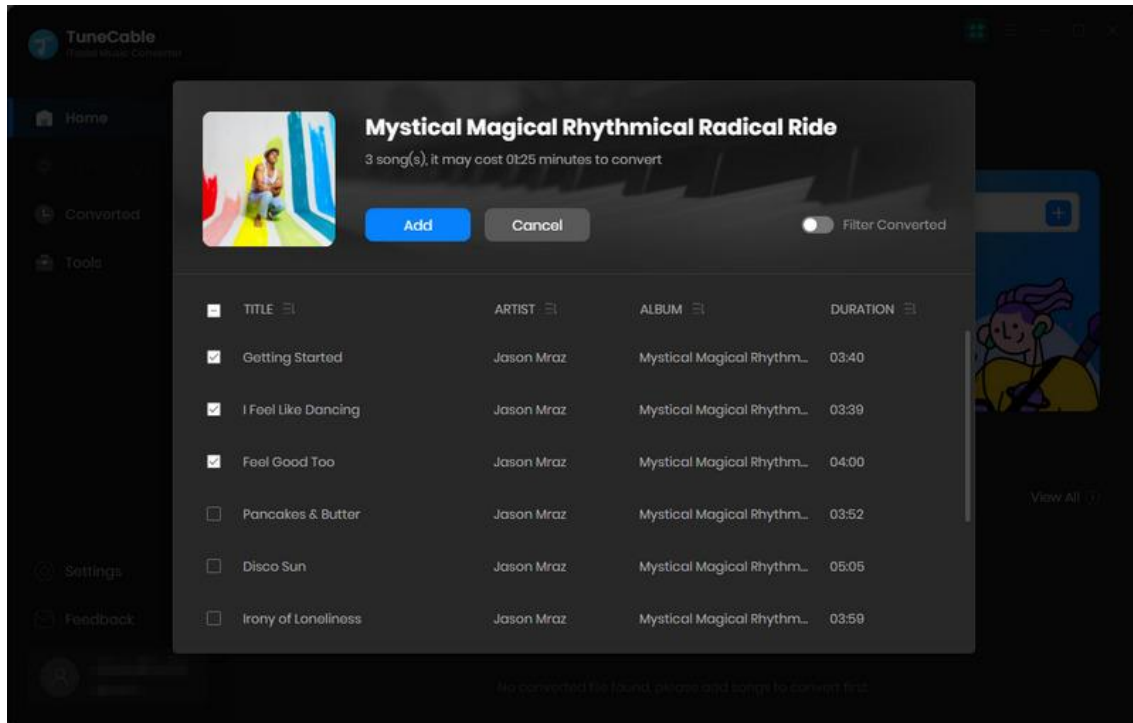
Step 2. Click on the “**Settings**” tab, and then there will be an interface that allows you to set the output parameters. TuneCable provides 6 downloading formats, you can convert songs to MP3, AAC, WAV, FLAC, AIFF, and ALAC formats. Other settings parameters like conversion mode, output quality, saving path, and naming format are ready for you to customize.

- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Tidal Record, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album

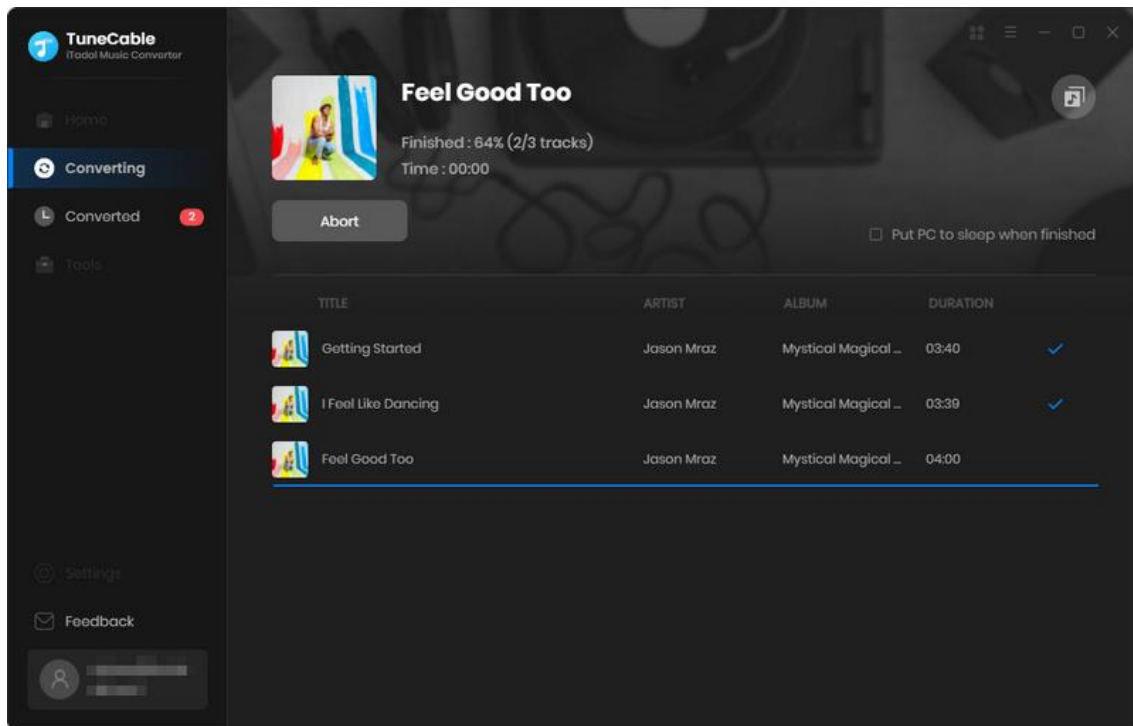
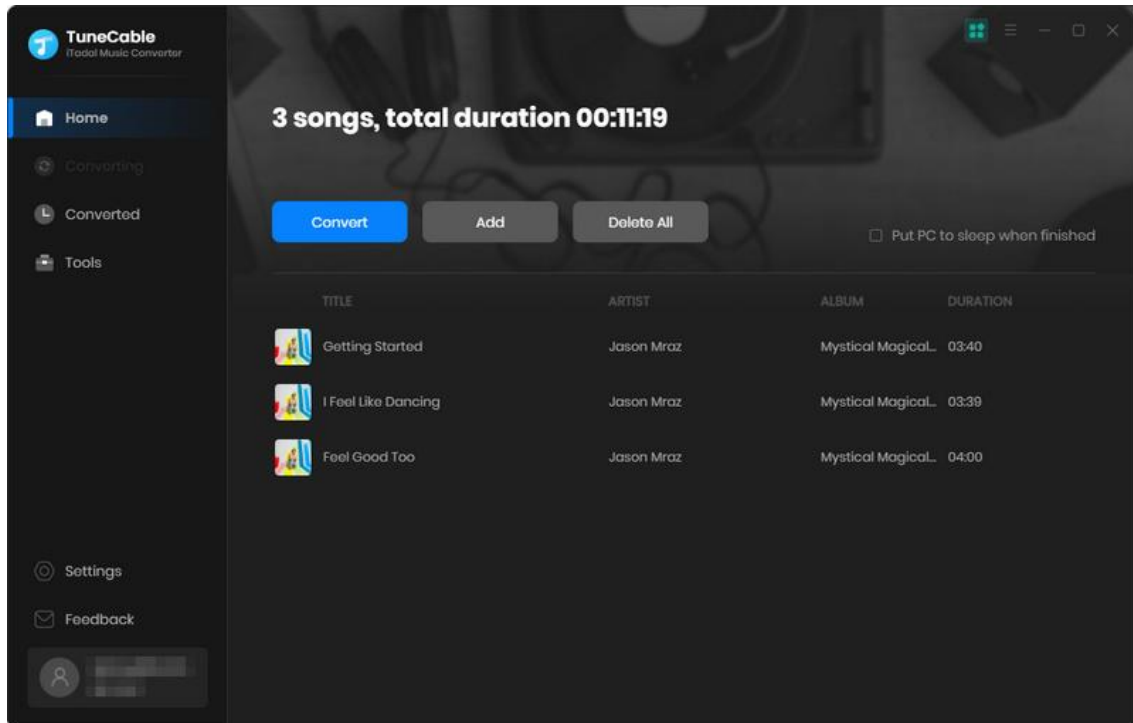
If you prefer the source format and original HiFi/MQA quality, you may select ‘AUTO’ from Output Format and ‘Tidal Record’ from Conversion Mode.



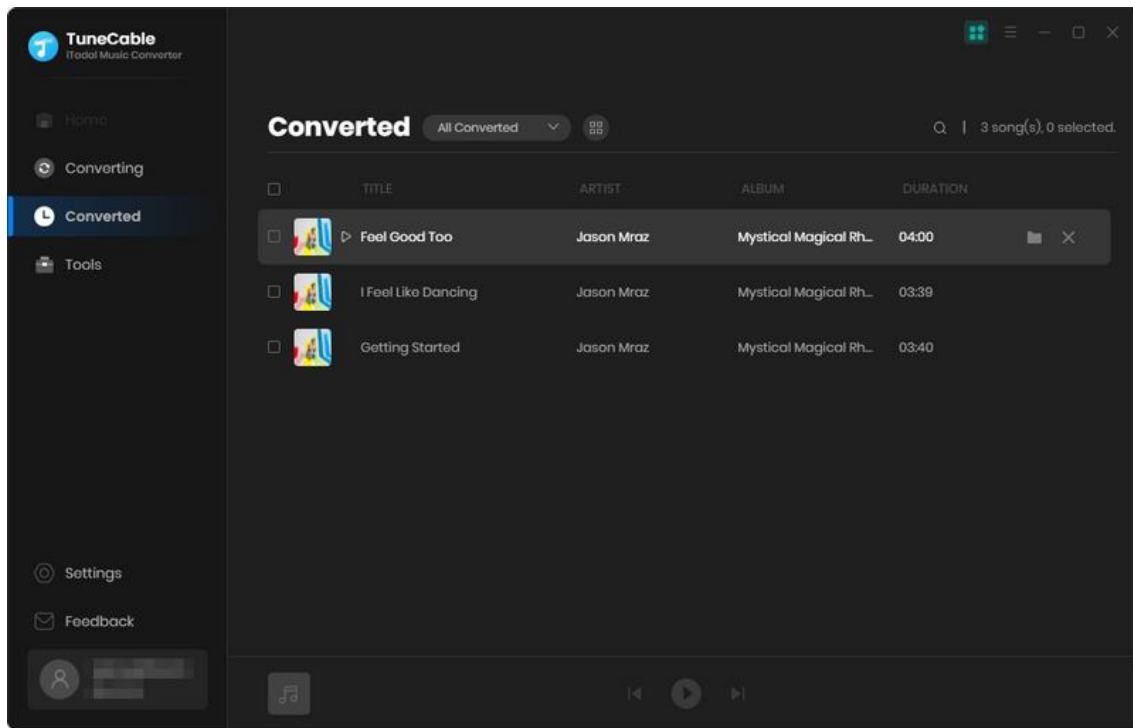
Step 3. Head over to the TIDAL app, then drag and drop the track to the specific detect area in TuneCable directly. Or you can copy the link (right-click the song, and then choose "Share" >> "Copy Track Link" or right-click the title of an album/playlist, then choose "Copy link address"), then go back to TuneCable and paste the link into the input box. TuneCable will then parse the link and load the tracks on a popup. Pick your preferred tracks and click on **"Add"**.



Step 4. When finish adding, click the **"Convert"** button to start conversion. If you would like to add more songs to this batch, click on the **"Add"** button on this page and TuneCable will allow you to add more songs from the TIDAL app. When converting, TuneCable proceeds with the tracks at up to 5x the speed.



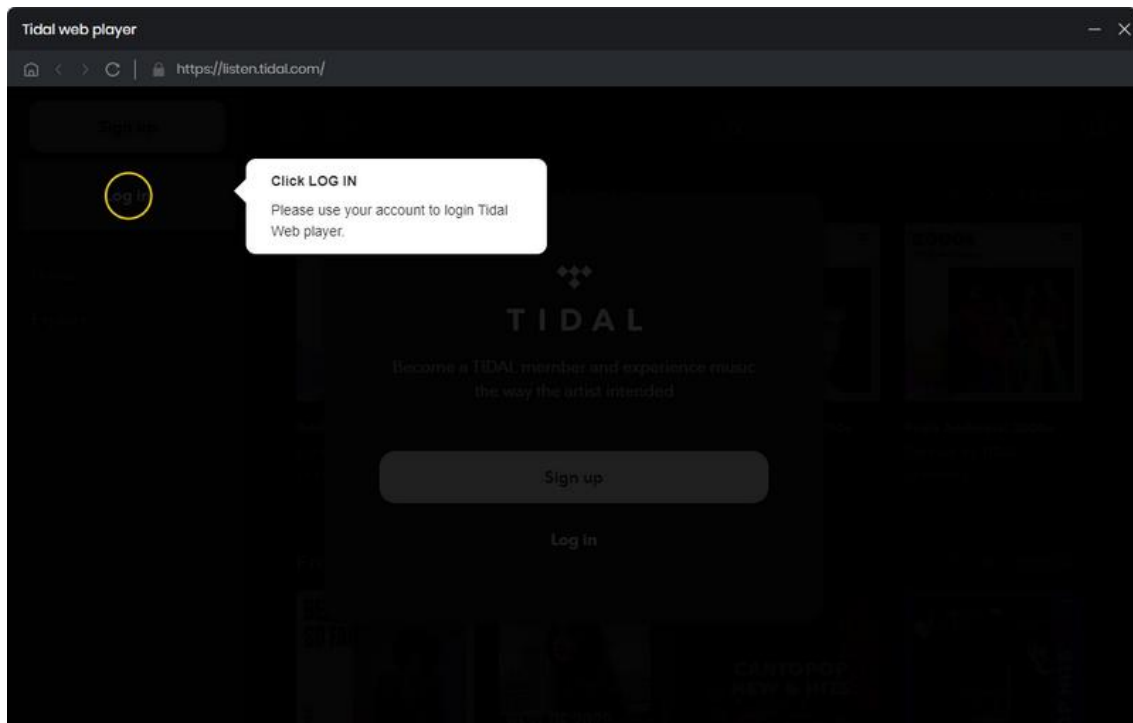
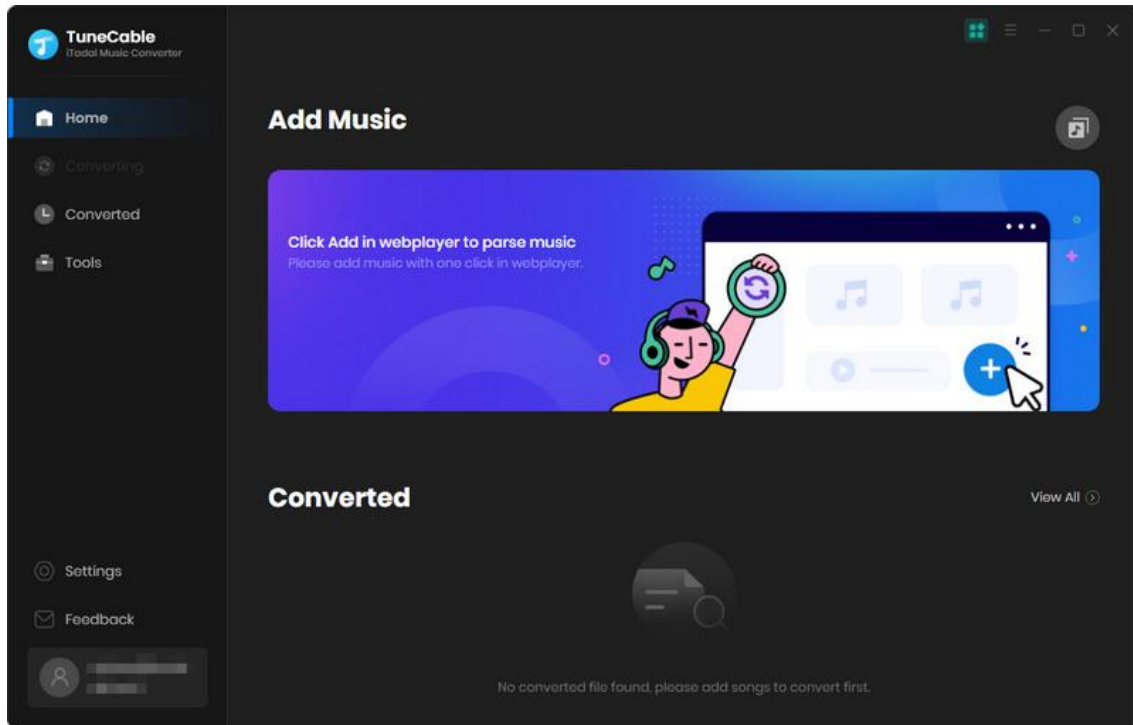
Step 5. After conversion, click "**Converted**" to find your converted Tidal Music tracks.



Note: If you need to share or transfer the converted Tidal music, you could click the menu button above the tracks. TuneCable provides options for you, which are "Export to iTunes", "Burn CD", and "Tag Edit". TuneCable also offers a music playback function.

Download Tidal Music with Tidal Web Player

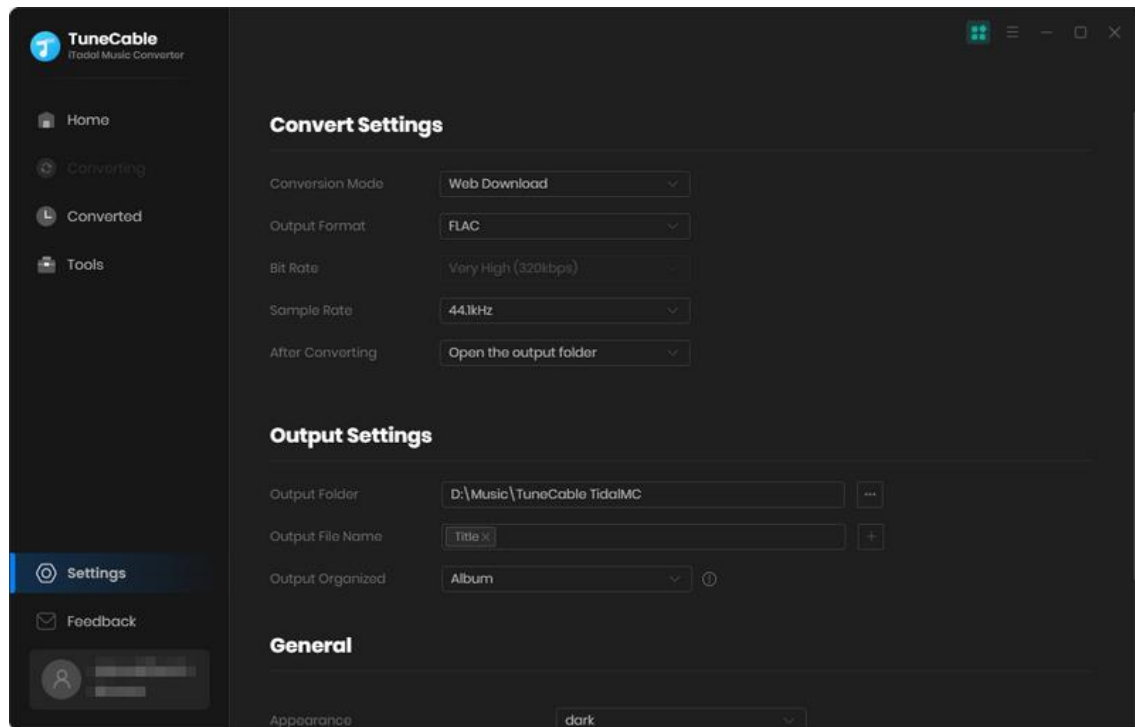
Step 1. After launching TuneCable on your PC and selecting to use the Tidal web player to download music, TuneCable will enter the web player mode and the Tidal web player will occur as an independent window. You need to log in to your Tidal account to access its library.



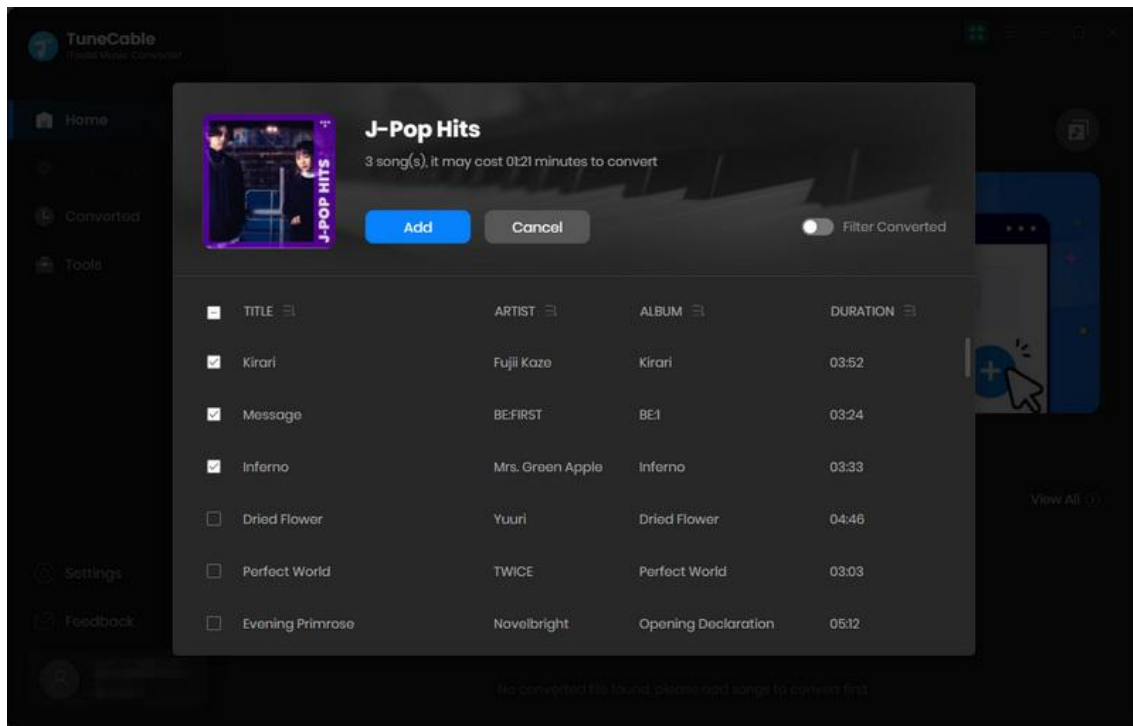
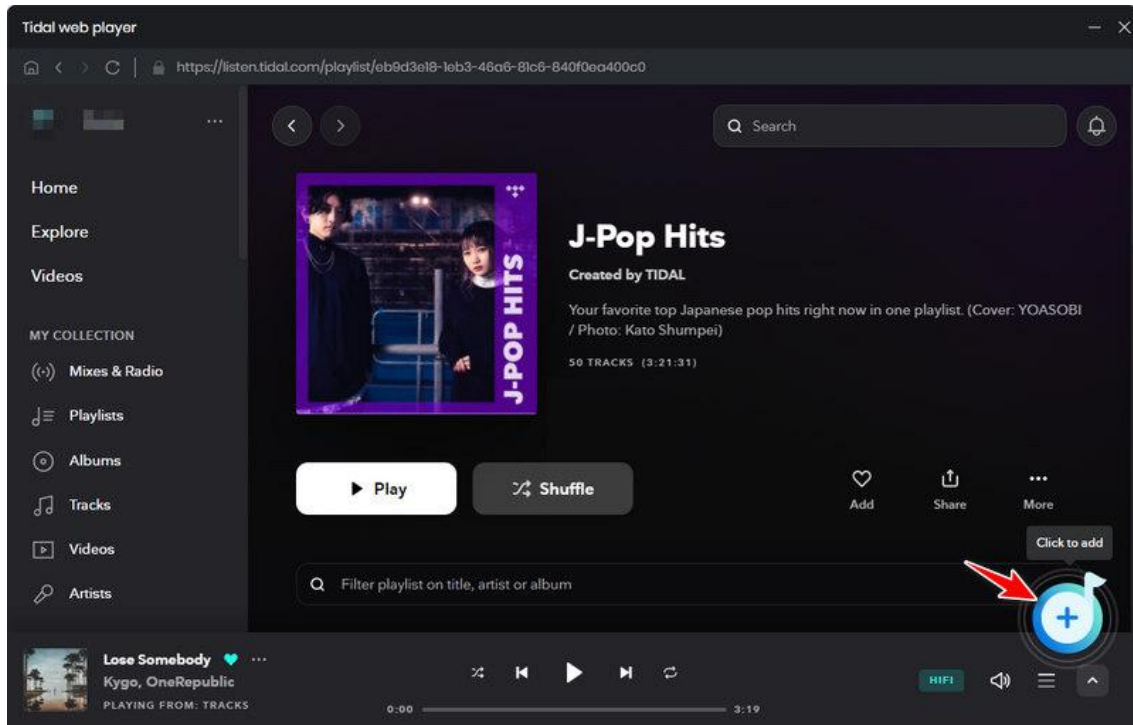
Step 2. Click on the **“Settings”** tab on TuneCable’s window, and then there will be an interface that allows you to set the output parameters.

- Conversion Mode: Intelligent Mode, Web Download, YouTube Download
- Output Format: AUTO, MP3, AAC, WAV, AIFF, ALAC, FLAC
- Bit Rate: 128kbps, 192kbps, 256kbps, 320kbps
- Sample Rate: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, 192kHz
- Output Folder: To your preference
- Output File Name: Track Number, Title, Artist, Album, Playlist Index, Year
- Output Organized: None, Playlist, Artist, Album, Artist/Album, Album/Artist, Playlist/Artist, Playlist/Album

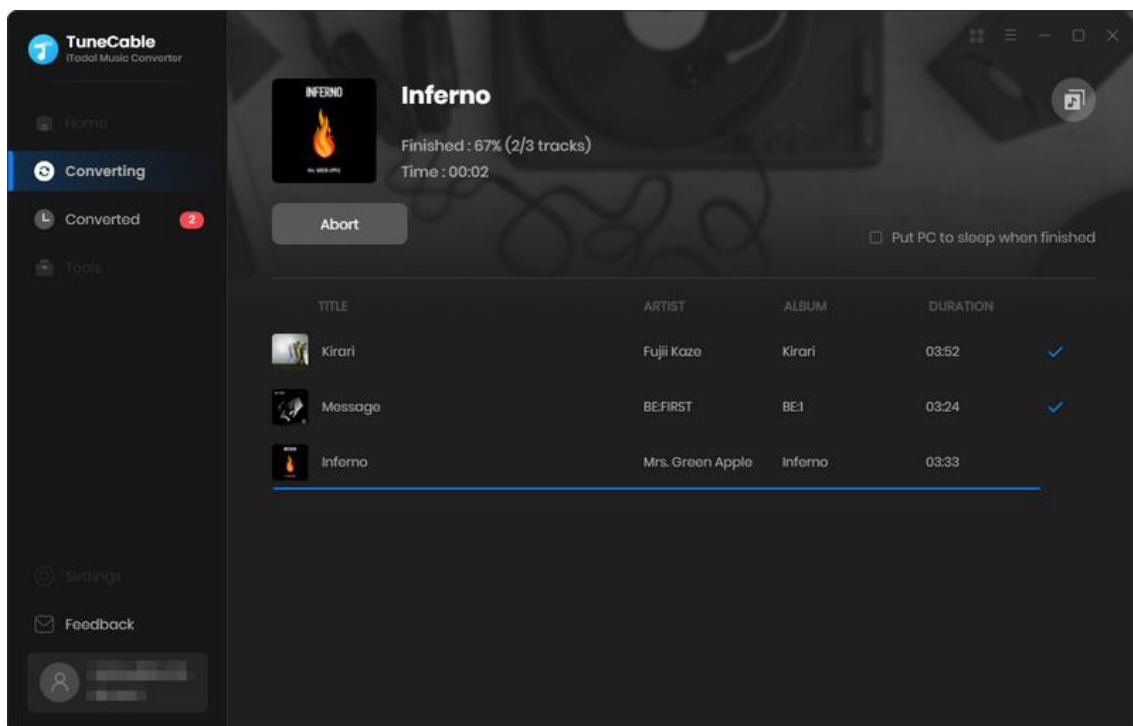
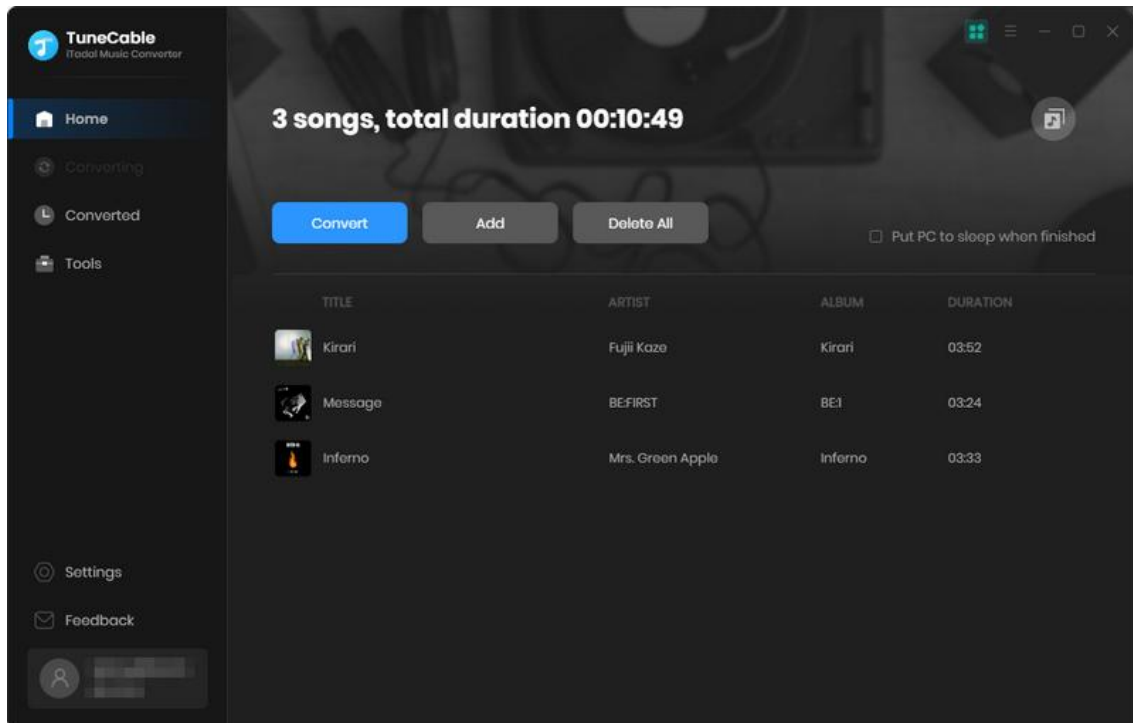
If you prefer the source format and original HiFi quality, you may select ‘AUTO’ or ‘FLAC’ from Output Format and ‘Web Download’ from Conversion Mode.



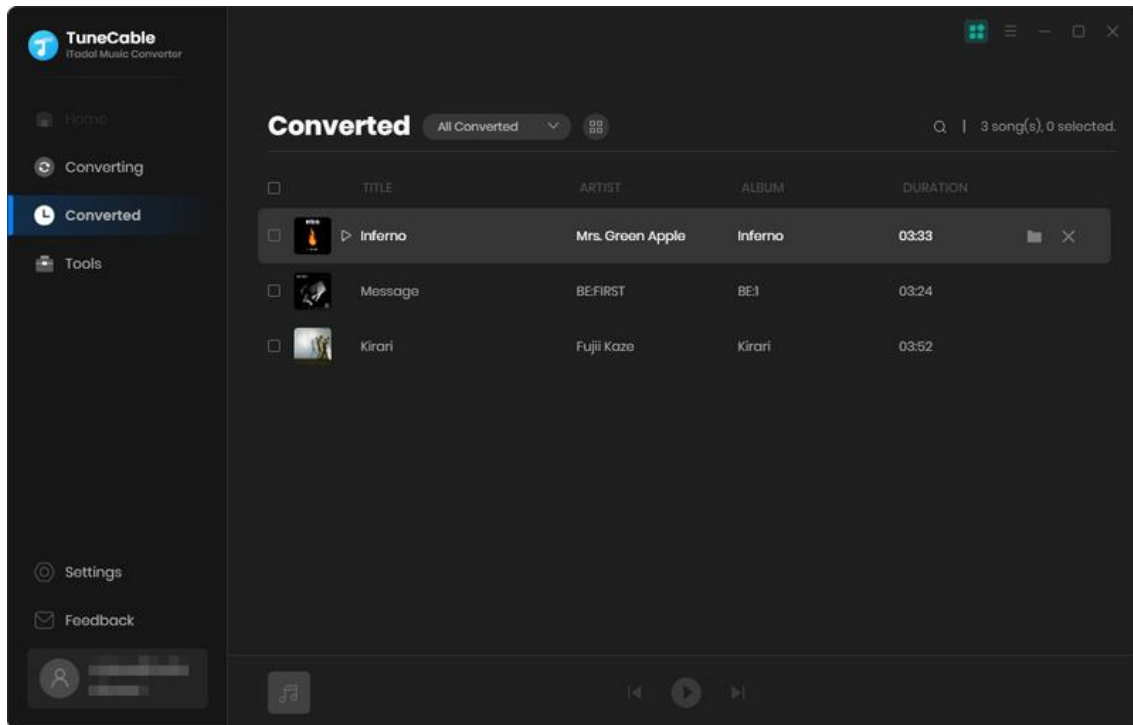
Step 3. Browse the Tidal web player and go through your favorite songs, playlists, albums, and even podcasts. Hit on "Click to add" and TuneCable will load all the available songs on the current page. Pick specific songs and hit on "Add". If you plan to add more songs, simply repeat this step.



Step 4. After all the songs are added, click on the **"Convert"** button to start downloading Tidal songs to your local computer. TuneCable will run at up to **10x** the speed to proceed with these tracks.



Step 5. After the conversion is finished, you can view the converted Tidal songs by going to **"Converted"**. Then you can transfer the songs to your other devices and enjoy Tidal songs freely at any time.

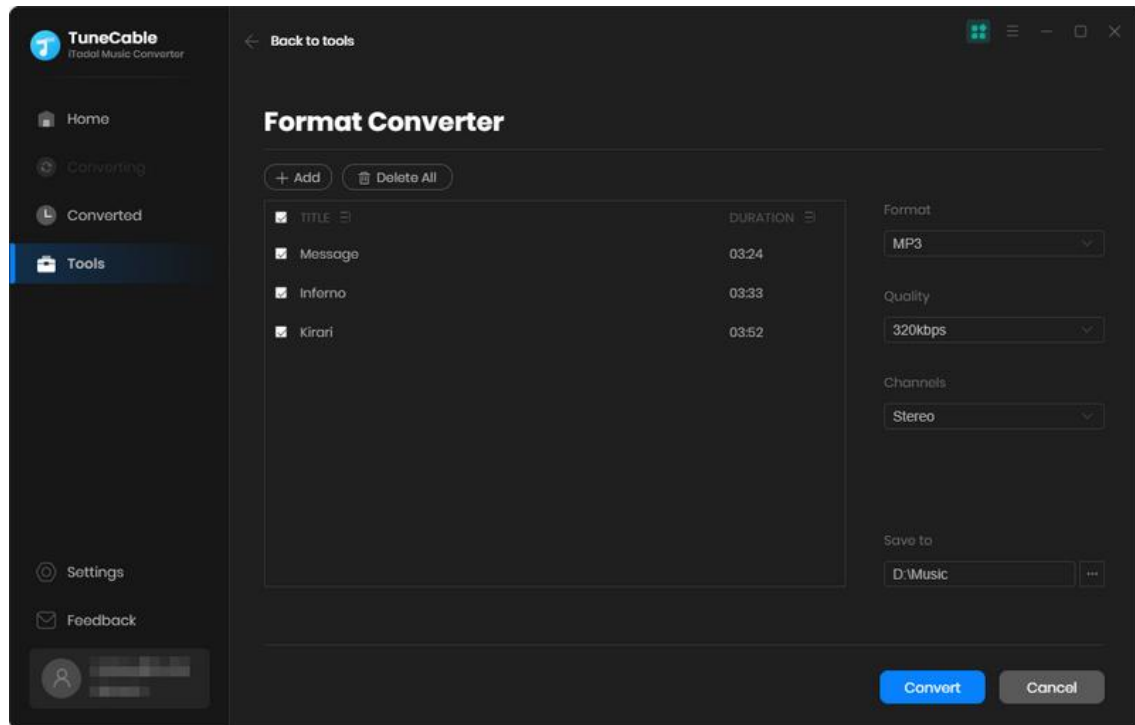


Format Converter

This tool allows you to convert music or your local audio files to **MP3, M4A, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, and OGG**.

Step 1. Navigate to Format Converter from the Tools section. Then you can import local audio files to the converter by clicking "**+Add**". Another way is to drag and drop the songs to TuneCable directly. The supported source format includes MP3, M4A, M4B, WAV, FLAC, OGG, AIFF, and M4R.

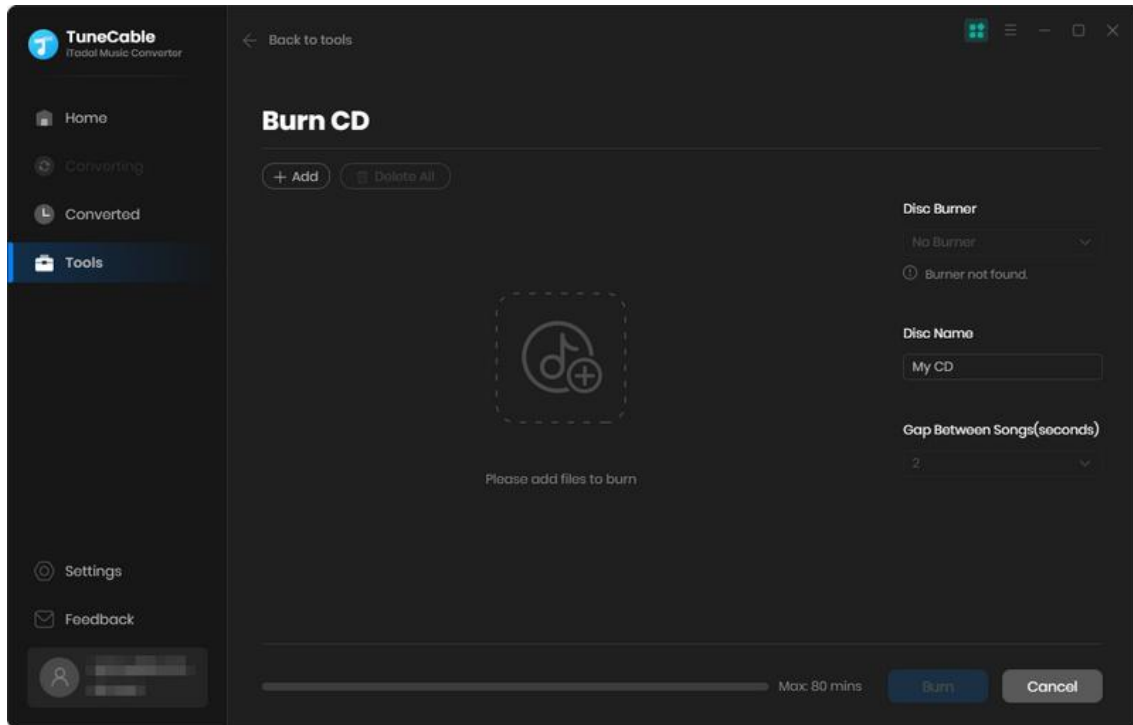
Step 2. Select an output format, sound quality, etc. and click on "**Convert**" to start the conversion.



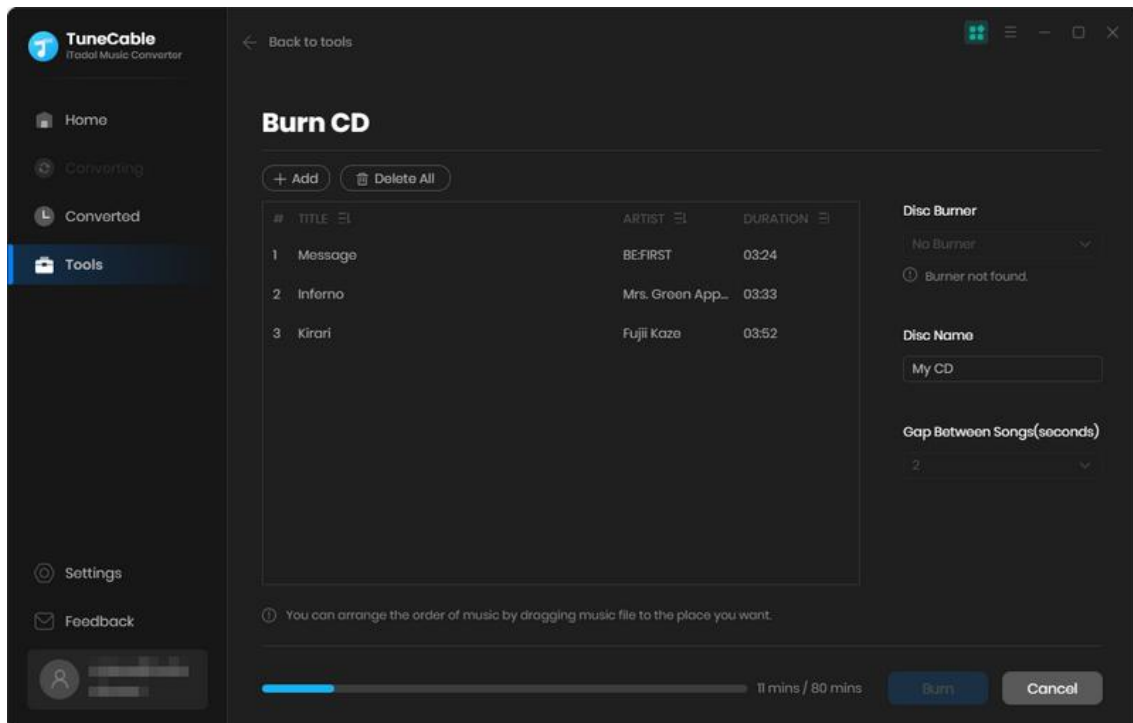
Burn CD

TuneCable provides the function to help you burn music to CD more conveniently, step into this part.

Step 1. Navigate to the Burn CD tool. Then you can import local audio files to the converter by clicking "+Add". You can also drag and drop the wanted files to TuneCable.



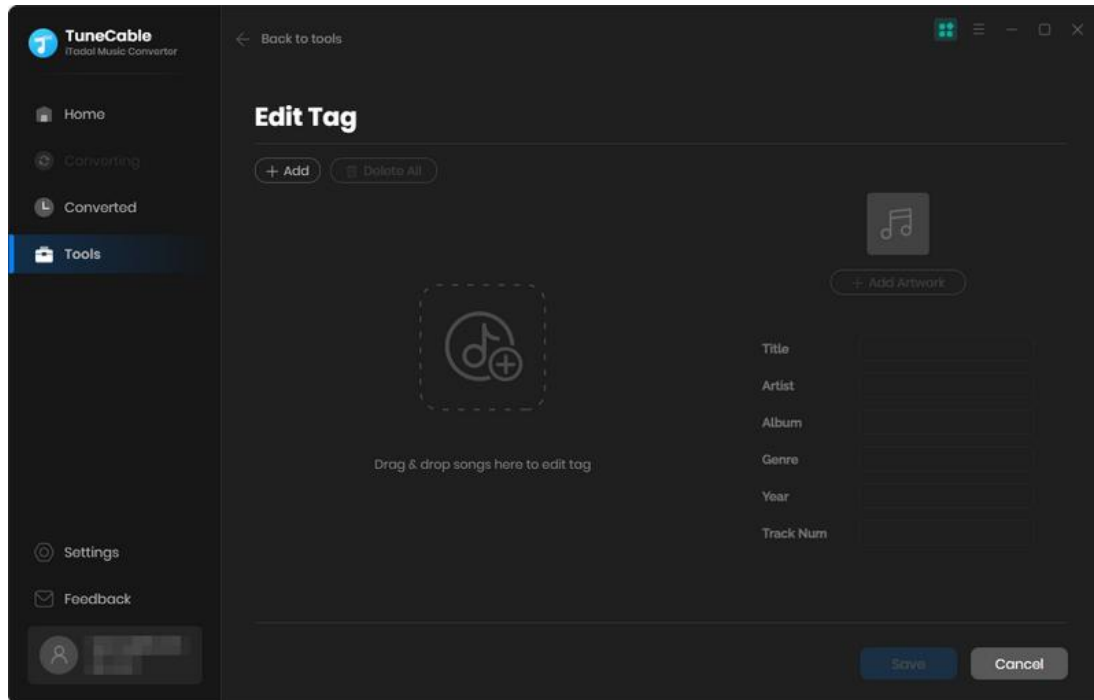
Step 2. Insert a CD into your computer. Change the burning parameters and hit on "Burn" to start.



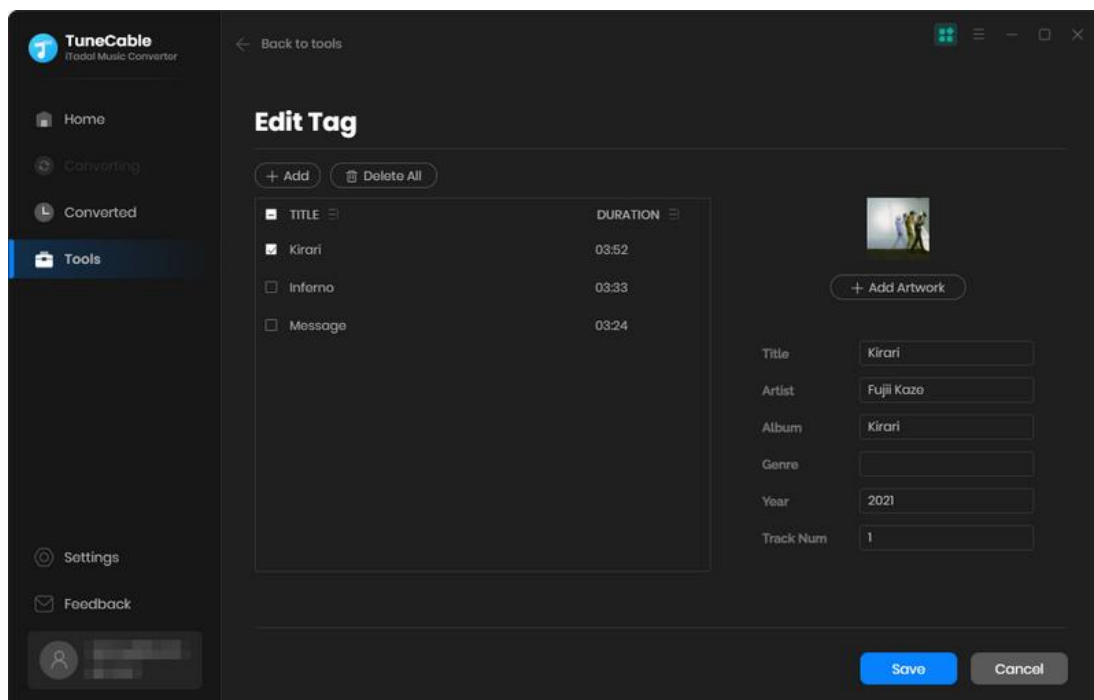
Tag Edit

This function allows you to edit the ID3 tags of a song. You can change the information of Artwork, Title, Artist, Album, Genre, Year, and Track Num.

Step 1. Drag and drop your local files to TuneCable. The "+Add" button also allows you to upload files.



Step 2. TuneCable will show the tags on the files. You can add tags or change the tags accordingly. Then click "Save" to apply all changes.
